

Printing & Saving Discussion Posts

1. Click on the **Discussions** tab in the mini navbar.

2. Click on the **title** of the discussion board you want to print.

Respond to one or more of the questions: What is the archetype that is insincere or inferior within me and which may lead me into living parts of my life inauthentically? What archetypal roles do I struggle with that may keep me from my true or truer vocation? Where have I chosen a vocational path that feels like a compromise, as Jung did initially with medicine, and why?

As you read each other's response, look for common themes that emerge. Of course the person is speaking from their individual, particular perspective, but also, we all speak also as members of a collective. What is the collective saying through us about the difficulties of being true to thine own self?
